DRAW YOUR EXISTING ROOM

Draw your room on the grid below. Keep in mind that each large square equals one foot and each small square equals three inches. Be sure to note the locations of doors, windows, electrical outlets, plumbing fixtures, ventilation, and major appliances. **Once your design is completed, it is strongly recommended that you or your installer validate the dimensions on the design rendering.**

- Answer all questions and provide all measurements
- Accurately measure the room, noting door and window locations
- Check-off appliances and provide dimensions
- Double-check all measurements in your floor plan drawing
- Include photos of the existing room
